

New titles in Version 11.0 (it is possible to add new books only with upgrading the software).

5,250 new books were added to the main Otzar HaHochma package.

This update contains an expansive and diverse collection. It includes the commentaries of Rishonim and Acharonim; books from both ancient and modern times; new editions of works by current Torah scholars and *roshei yeshivah, zt"l*; books on Halachah and Jewish customs; ancient prayer books; liturgy; books on the history of various communities and biographies of Torah scholars. Bibliographies and catalogues have also been included.

Many of the books in this update have been specifically requested by Otzar users. We have tried our best to satisfy such requests for missing works .

This update also includes about two hundred books provided by the National Library of Israel. The library has generously contributed rare and hard-to-find books, first editions of commentaries on the Torah by Rishonim, ancient siddurim and machzorim, books on Kabbalah and Midrash, and more. These books have undergone high-quality color scanning. There was a problem with the books' appearance in the previous update, and we have fixed the issue.

While a detailed list of over five thousand books appears at the end of the letter, we have also included a small but representative sampling from each category of the main list (mainly the more famous and well-known titles) that should give you a feel for what's coming.
